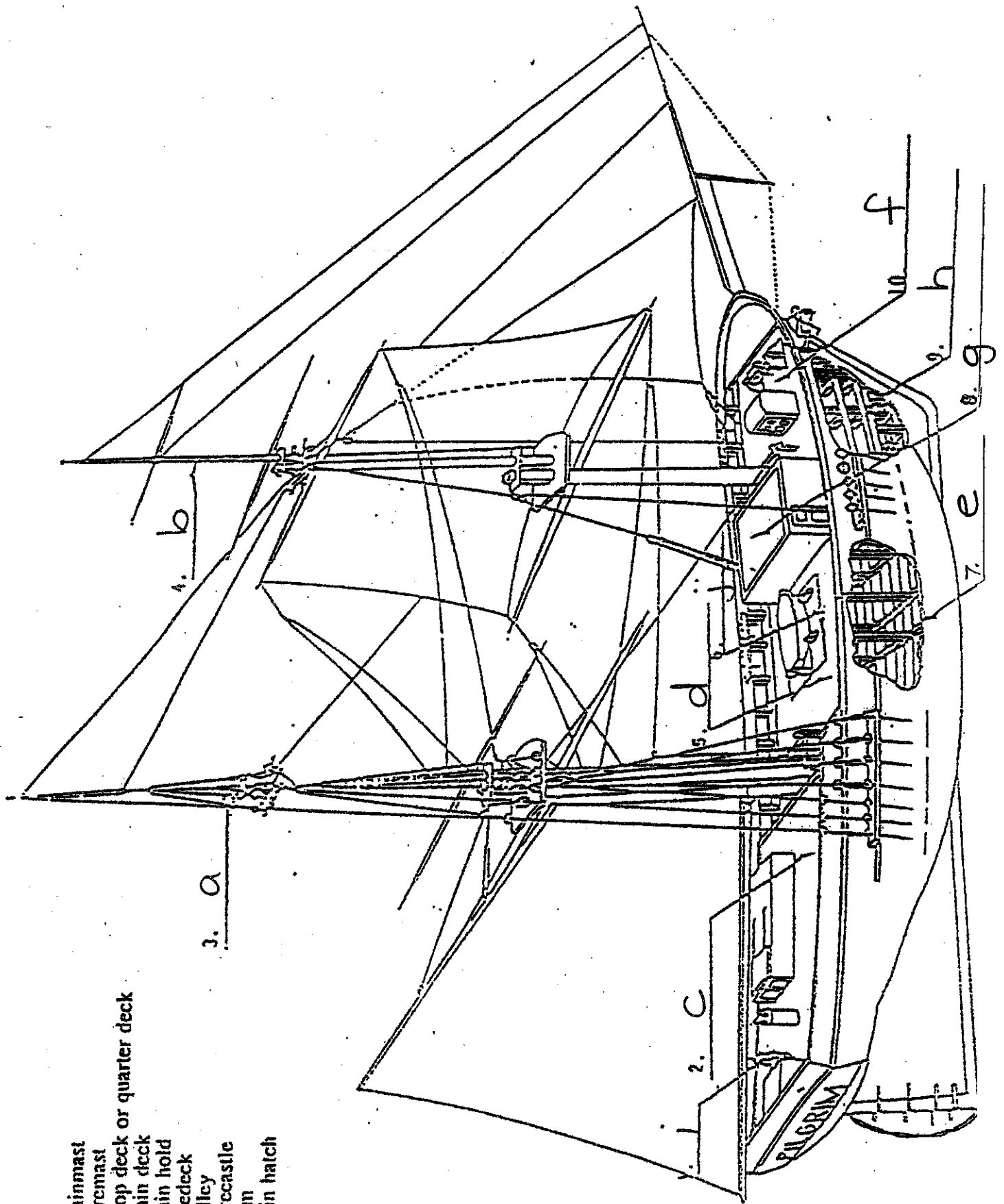


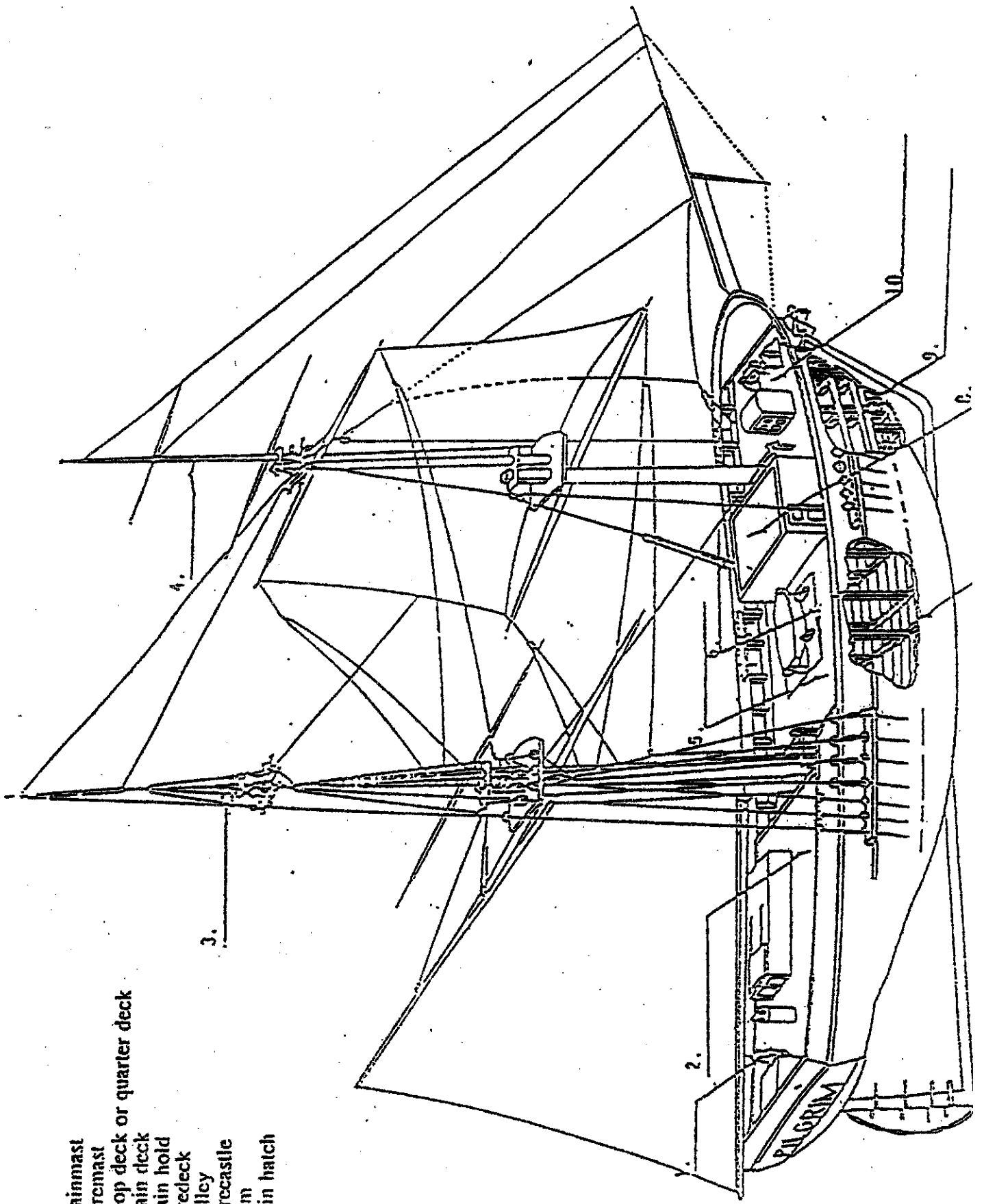
PILGRIM VOCABULARY

1. Aft - In the rear, to or towards the stern
2. Anchor - Iron or iron and wood device to hold the ship in place
3. Avast - Stop, quit what you are doing
4. Bight - The bend or loop of the rope
5. Bitter End - The very end of a piece of rope
6. Block - Wood or metal case for a sheave
7. Boatswain - Person responsible for the ship's maintenance
8. Bow - The whole forward end of the ship
9. Fathom - Six feet, a measurement of length
10. Forecastle - Raised part of the deck in the bow or crew's quarters
11. Foremast - The first mast in line
12. Galley - The kitchen on a boat
13. Hatch - An opening in the deck
14. Head - The ship's toilet
15. Hull - The whole body of a ship
16. Line - The sailor's word for rope
17. Mainmast - A sailing vessel's principle mast
18. Poop - The high deck at the stern

19. Port - The left side of the vessel, as one stands facing forward
20. Rowlock - Opening in which an oar is pivoted when rowing
21. Slack away - To pay out rope without losing control of the rope
22. Standing part - The main part of a rope
23. Starboard - The right side of the boat as one stands facing forward
24. Stern - The whole after or back end of a ship
25. Stow - To put away in its proper place
26. Tackle - Rope rigged through and around pulleys
